Qualitative Analysis

General Purpose:

Find meaning that subjects attach to human interaction.

Qualitative Analysis: Characteristics

- (1) Free-form
- (2) Concurrent to data collection
- (3) Data are words and symbols
 Multiple meanings
 Context based
- (4) Focus: Constructing theory
 Combining empirical evidence to build
 concepts

Coding

Coding is the process through which a researcher finds meaning in the data (notes of observations, interview transcripts, etc.)

Coding: Purpopses

- (1) Reducing the data to a manageable size
- (2) Finding patterns
- (3) Developing categories/concepts

Coding: Process

Iterative (trial and error) process

- (1) Open Coding Finding themes
- (2) Axial Coding
 Organizing themes into meaningful categories

Finding Meaning

- (1) Noting patterns and themes
- (2) Clustering or factoring
- (3) Subsuming particulars to the general
- (4) Counting

Finding Meaning

- (5) Making contrasts and comparisons
- (6) Finding intervening variables
- (7) Building a logical chain of evidence
