Preparing a Research Article

Quantitative Format:

1. Abstract
2. Introduction
3. Literature Review
4. Methods
5. Results
6. Discussion
7. Conclusion
8. List of References and Appendices

Qualitative Format:

No standard format, but should include a detailed methods section and concrete results

Describing Methods

- (1) What is the general approach? What was the study design?
- (2) How were the data collected (be specific - include type of survey, time & location, etc.)?
- (3) How were variables measured?
- (4) How was the sample selected (no. of subjects)?
- (5) How were ethical issues and design issues dealt with?
